

CONFRONTATIONS IN A CATHEDRAL

for Organ, Harp and Percussion

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Op. 84

For Peter Sweeney and the Dublin International Organ Festival 1986

Duration about 10 mins.

N.B. Being written for performance in a reverberant Cathedral, precise coordination in ensemble is not required. The Harp should be placed at the front of the Chancel, and the percussion should be some distance away - possibly as far as the Lady Chapel.

Metronome marks are an approximate indication. Speed will vary with different conditions
