INTRODUCTION

(Allow for plenty of interaction, and use this time to plan the counting song lyrics which come later in
the piece)*

When the audience are settled the show begins.

*Flossie and Farmer MacNeep enter. Flossie offers to sing a song, and Farmer MacNeep asks to be allowed
to play too.*

Flossie gives Farmer MacNeep an egg shaker from an egg carton and she picks up the ukelele.

*Once the song begins, the focus is on the two sheep puppets playing in the snow, making sheep noises etc..
At the end of the song, the sheep become trapped under the snow.*

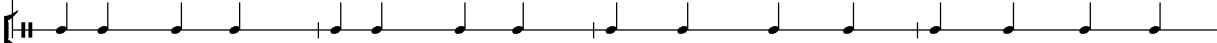

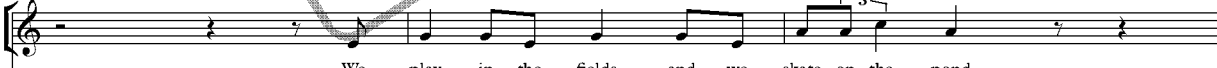

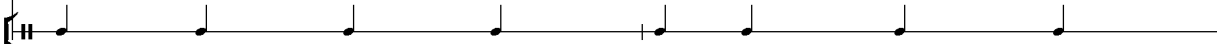
