The Contemporary Music Centre launches Solo Series I - CD series and concert programme

The Contemporary Music Centre launches *Solo Series I* produced by Diatribe Records in conjunction with the Contemporary Music Centre at 500pm – 630pm, Friday 16 April 2010 in the CMC, Fishamble Street, with performances from 730pm – 930pm in the Kevin Barry Room of the National Concert Hall.
