Artists & Creatives Collaborative Practice Award 2017



This 2017 Creative Ireland South Dublin initiative seeks to support an artist or creative in any discipline, or working across disciplines in their collaborative practice. The successful proposal will have both a professional development element and a community collaborative element to it. It will engage with one of the cultural venues or organisations in the county and may have access to mentoring opportunities by these venues and organisations. The amount of the award is €15,000.

This award is made possible under Pillar Two of the Creative Ireland Programme for 2017 - *Enabling Creativity in Every Community.*







Selection

The selection judges will develop a shortlist of applications that best meet the selection criteria and may request further information to help in the assessment of the shortlisted applications. The selection panel may also decide not to seek further information of shortlisted applicants.

Selection Criteria

- a. The extent to which the proposed event/project is aligned to the Creative Ireland Programme Pillar Enabling Creativity in Every Community;
- b. The extent to which the proposed event/project maximises community and citizen engagement;
- c. The extent to which the proposed event/ project is ambitious, innovative and fosters creativity;
- d. The potential scope of the event/project and anticipated target audience;
- e. The cost of the proposed event/project and any additional supports and funding that may be required or have been confirmed; and
- f. The feasibility of completion within the current year.

How to apply

- Please submit the attached application form.
- Please give the fullest possible description of the project or proposal (Max. two A4 pages) including a description of how the award will impact on the development of the artist and their practice.
- Provide a timeline for the project and a detailed costing of your proposal stating any income already confirmed.
- Applications should provide evidence of any agreements in place with mentors, funders, organisations and venues which relate to this proposal.
- Please include a current C.V. (curriculum vitae).
- Please provide online links to samples of your work.

Conditions

- The community of engagement must be within the South Dublin County Council Administrative Area.
- Proposals should include a public event as an outcome of the process.
- Applications will only be accepted by email.
- These awards will not fund third level undergraduate studies.
- Funding by Creative Ireland South Dublin must be acknowledged on any publicity material relating to the activity supported by the scheme. Logos are available from South Dublin County Council Arts Office.

- Successful applicants will be asked to participate in evaluation of the fund by providing a short written report on completion of the project. Copies of promotional material must also be submitted to the Arts Office.
- A tax clearance certificate may be required.
- Applications will be assessed in September 2017.
- Projects must be initiated in 2017 and completed before 31st March 2018.
- The selection panel reserves the right not to grant an award if the standard of applications does not satisfy the criteria of the award in full.
